






CONTROLLING NOISE IN INDUSTRY

INTRODUCTION

Acoustical control is an important factor in most environments and the Noise at Work Regulations 1989 now impose a duty of assessment and action on all employers that covers both new and existing premises.

With the greater awareness of the adverse effects of noise on staff efficiency and health a technology has been created over the years which enables the architect or engineer to reduce substantially, if not eliminate, many of the environmental problems hitherto caused by noise and vibration.

Sargents Acoustics has long been a leader in development of these technologies and today enjoys an established reputation for the design and manufacture of equipment to control noise and vibration. The Company currently offers an extensive range of acoustical equipment suitable for use in all applications.


In addition to sound resistant doors, panels and enclosures the product portfolio includes noise attenuators and vibration isolators; isolated floors and ceilings and attenuating louvres.

THE PROBLEM

High levels of noise and vibration can reduce worker efficiency or even cause hearing loss as well as precipitate complaints from neighbours. Effective control of noise in the workplace is thus of paramount importance and acoustical insulation of equipment, which can be the source of such nuisance, can dramatically improve the working environment. H.P. Fan Sets after treatment.




CONSTRUCTION

Enclosures are fabricated using modular panels. Each module is constructed as a non-homogeneous section using pre-galvanised mild steel with a perforated inner face filled with a highly absorbent, inert acoustic medium. A choice of stove-enamelled, powder-coated epoxy resin and plastic-coated finishes are available to suit individual requirements.

CUSTOM ENGINEERING

To ensure that equipment achieves the required degree of attenuation, Sargents sound-resistant enclosures can be custom-designed to suit any specification. Our manufacturing procedures allow for the construction of unusual shapes and materials to suit particular requirements.


